



'THE TRUMP DOCTRINE' IS AN 'AMERICA FIRST' NEW WORLD ORDER



In brief, the U.S. policy goal must be unapologetically twofold: to perpetuate America's own dominant position for at least a generation and preferably longer still; and to create a geopolitical framework that can absorb the inevitable shocks and strains of social-political change while evolving into the geopolitical core of shared responsibility for peaceful global management. A prolonged phase of gradually expanding cooperation with key Eurasian partners, both stimulated and arbitrated by America, can also help to foster the preconditions for an eventual upgrading of the existing and increasingly antiquated UN structures. A new distribution of responsibilities and privileges can then take into account the changed realities of global power, so drastically different from those of 1945.

US foreign and defense policy under Trump today is... nothing less than application of the Brzezinski geopolitical challenge and the preventive war notion of the Bush-Wolfowitz doctrine in context of today's emerging resistance to an American sole superpower domination.

In 1997 (Brzezinski) wrote (in [The Grand Chessboard](#)) that it was "imperative that no Eurasian challenger emerges, capable of dominating Eurasia and thus of also challenging America." He further declared,

"Potentially the most dangerous scenario would be an 'anti-hegemonic' coalition united not by ideology but by complementary grievances...

a grand coalition of China, Russia, perhaps Iran...

Averting this contingency...will require US geostrategic skill on the western, eastern, and southern perimeters of Eurasia simultaneously."

When we add to this the recent Pentagon National Defense Strategy document that defines Russia and China as the greatest potential threat to American hegemony, then combine this with the growing ties between Russia, China and Iran since lifting of sanctions in 2015, especially in Syria, it becomes clear what Washington is doing. They are in an all-out effort to break what I call the Eurasian Challenge to the sole hegemon—Russia, China, Iran.

As Brzezinski pointed out, for American purposes of continued domination, it matters not that there are ethnic, religious and other differences between Russia, China and Iran. US foreign policy since September 2001 has increasingly forced those three to cooperate, despite those differences, for what they see as defense of their national sovereignty.

U.S. LAWMAKERS SET \$717 BILLION DEFENSE BILL WITH EYE ON CHINA, RUSSIA, TURKEY

(EXCERPT) - U.S. House of Representatives lawmakers released details on Friday of a \$717 billion annual defense policy bill, including efforts to compete with Russia and China and a measure to temporarily halt weapons sales to Turkey.

On Russia, the proposed NDAA for fiscal year 2019 includes provisions such as imposing new sanctions on Russia's arms industry in response to treaty violations, prohibiting military-to-military cooperation and providing more funding for cyber warfare.

On China, the proposed NDAA includes provisions including improving Taiwan's defense capabilities and barring any U.S. government agency from using "risky" technology produced by Huawei Technologies [HWT.UL] and ZTE Corp, which a committee statement describes as "linked to the Chinese Communist Party's intelligence apparatus."

A hint at what is really at stake comes from talks that have gone on between the Netanyahu and Trump administration during the last few weeks before the strikes. For Israel, the real "red line" in Syria is not about chemical weapons – it's about Iran and Hezbollah's potential encroachment, through Assad's regime, on the Syrian-Israel border in the Golan Heights, or the Syrian-Jordanian border.

It would also ask the Defense Department to provide Congress with a report on the relationship between the United States and Turkey, and would block the sale of major defense equipment until the report was complete.

DENUCLEARIZATION: IMPERIAL FARCE NARRATIVE

It is imperative to know that the U.S. “denuclearization” demand in negotiation with North Korea is only an excuse to bring that country under its control. It was expected; not because Mr. Trump or Mr. Kim are “unpredictable” leaders. On the contrary, peace activists don’t think that the change of events is based on the personality of the “leaders”.

In the history of the American Presidency, Mr. Trump is not an exception as the corrupt media and Democratic Party want us to believe. Mr. Trump is the result of decades of a declining American economy. Politically he represents the weakness of U.S. Imperial power.
